Barrington Area Home Schoolers Present Fundraising Donation for Haitian School

HOFFMAN ESTATES, IL: Members of the Barrington Area Home Schoolers (BAHS) group presented a donation of \$4,891 from their fundraising efforts to C.H. Dyer, President of Bright Hope.

BAHS held their 7th Annual Kids Used Toy Sale from June 15-17 in Crystal Lake. Parents and children collected and donated toys, selling them through a garage sale to benefit a school-feeding project in Haiti through a program at Bright Hope, a global missions organization.

Last year, BAHS sponsored Mayaya, a Haitian school. Their efforts raised enough money to feed and educate the underprivileged children for a year. This encouraged them to continue the Toy Sale again this year.

Reaching to meet this year's fundraising goal, BAHS organized "The Backyard Girls Club". Moms and daughters invited girls from ages 5 to 10 to attend a 3-day outing. For \$5 per girl, they were able to play games, do crafts, and enjoy fellowship together. The themes of each day's event were Hawaiian, Crazy Sports, and Carnival. The Backyard Girls Club raised \$356 to add to the BAHS Toy Sale funds.
