Bright Hope's Mission and Vision:

Bright Hope is a non-profit organization with 45 years of experience dedicated to bringing Hope to those living on less than \$1 a day. Bright Hope envisions a world where under-resourced, local, in-country churches transform their communities and bring Hope to the extreme poor.

Job Description:

A Bright Hope Intern is a member of the Bright Hope field staff responsible for increasing the effectiveness and impact of the local ministry Partner through the support and assistance of the Partnership Developer (PD). A Bright Hope Intern implements new projects, conducts field research, provides administrative assistance, and reports to the Partnership Developer.

Job Requirements

- Internship length: 9 months to 1 year
- Ability to raise support to cover internship expense
- Strong written communication skills
- College degree or work experience in a developing country
- Strong computer skills (particularly Excel and Word)
- Photography and creative skills preferred
- Knowledge of Spanish preferred

Job Responsibilities:

- Work with PD to create a development strategy for selected partners
- Implement strategy, support projects as needed and report on developments
- Assist with information flow from PDs to Bright Hope headquarters
- Research industry best practices in Christian, holistic development
- Lead one to two responsibilities within Bright Hope South America
- Trips to all partners and projects in Bolivia, Peru and Chile
